individual measurement scheme for gas heating consumption. As a result, the potential of gas combi-boilers capable of supplying both gas heating and hot water supply have has attracted a great deal of attention. In 2004, the market share of individual gas combi-boilers represented 21% of the nation's heating equipment market, and it is estimated that the number of gas combi-boilers sold will increase to approximately 410,-000 units in 2008, more than double from from the 200,-000 units sold in 2004.

By staging this seminar, Hong Kong Towngas and Hong Kong & China Gas Investment Limited aim to foster exchanges between members of the profession and to promote energy conservation in residential buildings by giving members of the public a better understanding on the latest market trends in multi-functional gas-fired heaters—gas combi-boilers—as well as the latest endeavours foradvances in energy conservation in residential buildings.
