(25 September 2017) Approximately 45,800 elderly living in nursing home in Hong Kong are suffering from different severity of dysphagia. To allows elderly and for dysphagia patients to enjoy the delight of mooncake tasting alongside with their family and friends, The Hong Kong and China Gas Company Limited (Towngas) and St. James' Settlement join hands to create the first Warming Mooncake. On 23 September, Towngas organised an elderly home visit at St. James Settlement, to try the Warming Mooncake and pre-celebrate the Mid-Autumn festival.

The Warming Mooncake has received widespread acclaim and popularity among the elderly, they praised the mooncakes are served in moderate taste with distinct mousse layers

We understand the difficulties of elderly patients suffering from dysphagia, who may not be able to taste their favourite festive foods, thus the Warming Mooncake is designed to for the elderly to enjoy this traditional Mid-Autumn treat and taste its festive joy, even if they are suffering from dysphagia."

Dysphagia is prevalent among the elderly Create Warming Mooncake to allow elderly enjoy the delight of mooncake tasting

Eating problems due to illness or physical weakness are prevalent among the elderly, with approximately 45,800 elderly living in nursing home in Hong Kong are suffering from different severity of dysphagia. An estimated 60% of elderly nursing home residents and 40% of elderly day care recipients¹ require minced or pureed meal arrangements². Since the viscuous lotus seed paste can cause choking or suffocation, while the salted egg yolk is difficult to digest, elderly is discouraged from eating traditional mooncakes. To help the elderly and patients suffering from dysphagia fully enjoy the Mid-Autumn Festival with their families, Towngas invited registered dietitian and chef of St. James' Settlement to create elderly suitable Warming Mooncake in four flavours. The team underwent various round of trial and insist to retain the original taste of food when they created the warming mooncake, hoping the elderly can taste the original flavour even they have difficulties in swallowing and improve their life quality by meeting the tasting and nutritional needs of the elderly

Elderly show their satisfying smiles after tasting the Warming Mooncake as the tasty mooncakes warm their heart. Ms. Choi, who aged 86, needs to pay high attention on her diet, "mooncake is our must-have festive food in Mid-Autumn Festival, however my family members only allow me to have few sips of mooncake as traditional mooncake is greasy and not good to health. This warming mooncake is low calories; its silky texture allows me to swallow easily, so we don't need to worry about suffering from choking or suffocation. I am very excited to enjoy more Warming Mooncake in this year's festival."

Joyce Kwan, a registered dietitian at St. James Settlement mentions, "To meet the needs of the elderly, the Warming Mooncake uses ingredients like sweet potato, which provide nutrients that they may have difficulty intaking from vegetables, delivering both great taste and better health."

² Minced meals have been chopped or minced into small pieces and are soft in texture and easy to chew. Pureed foods need to be prepared using a blender or food processor, with texture similar to that of baby cereal, smooth with no coarse lumps, suitable for patients suffering from severe dysphagia.

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

Warming Mooncake serves with four flavours, and they are: green tea with adzuki beans, purple sweet potato with adzuki beans, chocolate sweet potato with egg custard and sweet potato with egg custard. Steam over water with medium-low heat for 20 minutes, then the steam hot mooncake is ready to serve which warms your heart.



Green Tea Warming Mooncake with Adzuki Beans Green tea and adzuki beans have always been the best partner; the crust is made of selected quality green tea powder and sweet potatoes; mild green tea blended with fragrance sweet adzuki bean paste, it gives such a refreshing Japanese taste to Hong Kong green tea lovers
