# Towngas Launches Low Carbon Action! Campaign Mass Pledge to Reduce Carbon Emission by One Million Tonnes

(10 October 2009) The Hong Kong and China Gas Company Limited (Towngas) today launched the "Low Carbon Action!" campaign, encouraging Hong Kong people to join hands in reducing carbon emission by one million tonnes in a bid to help save the much polluted planet.

According to figures from the Environmental Protection Department, the average annual carbon emission of Hong Kong people per person amounts to 6.7 tonnes. In our daily activities, from a small light bulb to large vehicles, carbon dioxide is constantly being produced, which leads to serious damage to the health of our planet. However, if everyone is prepared to devote a little bit of effort and start to reduce carbon emission in our daily lives, we will be able to help arrest the trend of global warming.

As Hong Kong's lead supplier of low carbon clean energy, Towngas takes environmental protection as its corporate responsibility. A series of green activities organised by Towngas will commence in the coming year to heighten public's awareness on environmental protection, encouraging people to lead a low carbon lifestyle. Officiating guests attending the opening ceremony of "Low Carbon Action!" campaign included Secretary for the Environment Edward Yau Tang-wah, Towngas Managing Director Alfred Chan Wing-kin, Chief Executive Officer of Green Power Dr. Man Chi-sum, Director of Friends of the Earth Edwin Lau and Deputy Chief Executive of the Conservancy Association Rico Wong. At the occasion, some guests also took part in a fun bike relay to promote creative low carbon tips.

Alfred Chan Wing-kin said, "Towngas has devoted over the years efforts and resource for environmental protection. We have launched various green initiatives in our business operations. The introduction of natural gas as feedstock, and the utilisation of landfill gas have resulted in a total reduction of carbon emission by 17%. In the coming year, we will continue our effort in implementing various energy saving and carbon reduction measures to avoid carbon emission by over 110,000 tonnes. We are set to reach a challenging target to cut carbon emission by one million tonnes. With

this in mind, we need the effort from all sectors. We hope that through this city-wide "Low Carbon Action!" environmental campaign, we can assemble Hong Kong people, especially our next generation, to join hands with us for a greener future.

Towngas invited 200 primary school students to participate in the event to broaden their knowledge on how to live a low carbon life. A ceremony was arranged where students pledged to live a low carbon life. Below is a list of easy low carbon tips that everyone can follow:

- Reduce shower time by 1 minute reduce carbon emission by 118g
- Replace 1 regular meal with vegetarian menu reduce carbon emission by 1,100g
- Reduce the use of computer by 1 hour reduce carbon emission by 137g
- Use town gas to cook 1 meal reduce carbon emission by 920g
- Bring your own water bottle reduce carbon emission by 500g
- Take public transportation for 1 journey reduce carbon emission by 5,380g
- Reduce buying 1 jacket reduce carbon emission by 3,000g
- Use local ingredients to cook 1 meal reduce carbon emission by 7,560g
- Wash 1 load of laundry with water below 60 degree Celsius reduce carbon emission by 1,360g
- Eat 1 less packet of potato crisps reduce carbon emission by 160g
