(20 March 2018) The Hong Kong and China Gas Co., Ltd. (3 HK) is pleased to announce its annual results today for the year ended 31 December 2017.

Results Highlights:

Group Results

- Profit after taxation attributable to shareholders of the Group for the year ended 31th December 2017 amounted to HK\$8,225 million, an increase of HK\$884 million or 12.1%
- Earnings per share amounted to HK58.8 cents (+12.1%)
- Final dividend of HK23 cents per share (Full year dividend amounted to HK 35 cents per share)
- Bonus shares: 1 for 10
- Inaugural energy green bonds issued in November 2017, amounting to HK\$600Mn and JPY2Bn

Hong Kong Core Business: Steady Business

- Total gas sale volume grew by 0.8%
- Commercial & Industrial gas volume rose by 2.6%
- Number of customers reached 1.88 million

Mainland Utilities Business: Progressing Well

- Operating profit after tax: HK\$3.7Bn, increased by 9%
- City-gas gas sales volume: 19.5Bn m³, rose by 14%
- Midstream gas volume: 4.7Bn m³, surged by 44%
- Adding 8 new projects (up to 28 Feb 2018)

New Energy Business: Steady Growth

- Operating profit increased 47% to HK\$0.4Bn
- 5 new projects to be commissioned in 2018 to 2019
- Focusing on in-house developed technologies
